4.A. Anderson Ranch Sculpture Project [TOSV SAAB Sculpture Partnership \(002\).pdf](#)

Elsie Rangel and Lindsay Fortier presented from Anderson Ranch.

Identified 2 sites with the help of Parks and Recreation that would work well for a sculpture:

- A. Tom Blake Trailhead
- B. Roundabout near Town Park

Two artists were presented:

Mark Handforth, based in NY/Miami and has 3 pieces that are available now for installation

Oscar Tuazon, interactive urban pieces, proposed for trailhead. The piece is interactive, can walk in through art.

Diane: Do we want sculpture to have a connection to Snowmass?

Elsie: Intention is to have a vibrant piece.

Gray and Ghislaine: Feels too urban

Lois: were you supposed to give more artist options for each location?

Ghislaine: We need better options regardless of timeline.

Roundabout better location, more exposure to greater population.

Presented 6 additional artists. SAAB preferred these artists to the original two.

Voted on preferred location. Majority voted for Roundabout over Tom Blake trailhead.

Pieces would be leased, not purchased. SAAB would pay for shipping only.
