3. C.O.R.E. UPDATE

Jamie explained that in February CORE worked with the housing department to submit a HEEHA (High Efficiency Electrification Heating Appliance) grant for the town's employee housing building the 'Green Goddess' to convert the electrify the heating system from a gas boiler system to heat pumps. The grant status should be known in about 4-6 weeks.
