- the culvert repair update is scheduled for June to Oct with closures to the intersection.
- fiber installation project delay
- Transportation Dept partnering with Transit App for tracking buses. It is the same app as RFTA and will be available mid - March - "Transit" app. We-Cycle will be on it as well.
- Post-Office - many complaints from locals - we are partnering with 5 other mountain towns to address issues and possible violations that the US postal service.
- Town Council Goals will soon to be formally adopted.
