Jamie presented a cost review analysis of electrification in Snowmass Village with the goal of impacting greenhouse gas emissions. The cost of fuel switching could amount to \$126 million dollars and CORE's investment in those projects through rebates/grants would then be ideally \$63 million dollars. For reference, current funding through grants and rebates for electrification and energy efficiency projects in all of Pitkin and some of Eagle Counties is around \$1.5 million annually. Presenting this information during the June 2 discussion with Council would be enlightening.
