8.D) Mall Transit Center Project

Sam Gaurino -
Transit Center designs. Incremental improvements. Feb 5th meeting talked about

Design Criteria. Cost and feasibility on couple different designs.

Looking for direction from Council.

Mayor started out the discussion - Incremental Improvements is the direction he recommends at this point. Need to look at the Shuttle stop as well to help improve it.

Fridstein presented an opposing view - need to combine the RFTA and the Shuttle. Worried that if we do Incremental, we will miss the opportunity to really improve to a FIRST CLASS Transit Facility- two levels, use his initial drawings and develop them to work for the space. Worth spending 15-20K to explore if this is possible.

Marolt- Hesitant and has questions. How much smaller and how much less impact for construction does that design present. Staff does not know some of those answers. Possibly 30% smaller. Possibly a little less impactful construction period with Fridsteins preliminary designs.

Gustafson - User experience is not working. Problem solving solution is putting them together in a Transit Center. Wants to see these designs taken to the next level, bring in business owners in beginning, and see if they will work.

Shenk - Solidified how the user experience need to be easy, mindless, straight forward. Asked how long Incremental Changes could take? Staff - One off season? not sure, need a bit more development to know that answer. Could Incremental feed into the larger project - like a step towards the bigger solution. Incremental plan that leads into a major new Transit Center.

Concern over disruption during construction.

Better feel from community

Need to look 10 yrs in the future and what we need - so much more of a need for transportation.

Public Comment - Brian Marshack - excited to see the ball moving forward. Not a waste of money cause we learned from it and interested in new possibilities. Evolve into something that could work. Combine RFTA and Shuttle, off Carriage Way, opportunity to help facilitate Mall redevelopment. Always do Incremental but kicks the can down the road and makes it difficult to move forward.

Gustafon, Likes the idea of looking further at Fridsteins design. In favor of a Transit Center, right location but needs to be more carefully done.

Jay Shumaker - Team looks alot tighter. Worth exploring. Concern about timeline.

Direction - Some Incremental improvements, money to look at design, Stakeholders input.

M=Need a motion

Direct Staff to get the engineering team to look at concept design to next steps - - Option 1 RFTA and Shuttle Stop below.
