Community Development Director Dave Shinneman briefly summarized the agenda item and introduced the Aspen Skiing Company representatives to present materials from the packet on the Divide Workforce Housing Sketch Plan Application.

The applicant went through the presentation on a proposal to develop 30 units of workforce housing at the top of Divide Way for the benefit of on-mountain employees. The application will be processed as a Major Amendment to the Divide PUD (Phase II) as approved by Ordinance No. 16 of 2001 which currently allows for the construction of an operations building with 3 housing units.

The Planning Commission and Town Council asked the applicant some clarifying questions regarding the project, traffic, parking, access issues, design, close proximity to the Ditch Trail, wifi and cell phone coverage, and lighting.

The application will next go to the Planning Commission on December 4, 2024, to conduct their review of the application. This is only the joint presentation to make the Planning Commission and Council aware of what is in the application and is not intended to be a review or action on the application.

Commissioner Doug Faurer moved to adjourn the Planning Commission joint meeting with Town Council. Commissioner Jim Gustafson seconded. All in favor.

Council briefly discussed each item from the Consent Agenda including getting the B & C survey on a future agenda, Pitkin County Library plans for a satellite branch in SMV, Councilmember Shenk sent some minor edits to Boucher on Minutes, next Council meeting will be Wednesday November 6th due to election and the room being used as a voting place, and a discussion about why Aspen funding disappeared for the homeless shelter funding.

Council also briefly discussed location of the leases and the amount of money in the IGA with Pitkin County for Little Red Schoolhouse.

Council had no comments to start with.

Public Comment:

Bill Tomcich presented to Council over the summer and sent info to Council which hopefully was helpful. He said there have been exaggerations on both sides. He gave Council some very detailed information on the aircrafts that were talked about at previous meeting.

Mayor motioned to approve Resolution No. 24, 2024. Shenk seconded to allow for further discussion.

Councilmember Fridstein agreed that there is a need to build a new runway, the decision is where to build. He stated that he is in favor of larger planes or increasing traffic but thinks there is a need to build the new runway in the new location. That said, he is not sure Council should pass this resolution in support.

Councilmember Gustafson commented that the interests of both resort and community are split. Not sure Council should weigh in on this. This Resolution of support may suggest a unified voice and she does not think we should pass this.

Councilmember Marolt commented that she is not in favor of passing this resolution and wants community members to have a voice not influenced by Council.

Councilmember Shenk commented that there are many opinions and some confusion. She is grateful for the conversations and the opportunities to educate the public on the issue. Stated that she wants to be available for questions and discussion in the community and has concerns that passing this resolution would hinder those conversations.

Councilmember Shenk and Mayor Madsen agreed to withdraw the motion. No action taken.

Finance Director Marianne Rakowski continued the budget review with Council specifically highlighting revenues, expenditures, funds available; budget philosophy; summary of account activity; Charts on revenues, expenditures and funds available; and outstanding debts.

Total revenues across all funds total \$157,149,244 excluding transfers between funds and the Aspen School District pass-through revenues. Total expenditure across all funds total \$168,633,685, excluding transfers between funds and the Aspen School District pass-through payment. The total expenditure includes \$123,919,040 in capital projects.

Budget discussion continued with the CIP Budget, 2025 project lists and descriptions. Projects include another culvert replacement that will be expensive and will take 4-5 months. This is going out to bid and once timing is determined, the Town will conduct community outreach and education on the project. Hope for a July start date.

Other projects discussed:

Entry way to SMV / Rodeo with additional landscape design with 500k in the budget. Council suggested painting stands and planting mature trees to enhance the entrance.

Benedict Trail enhancements to assist in connecting nodes. 270K available from 2024, budget will roll them forward and study possibilities.

Town Roads & Paved Trails – Public Works Director Anne Martens showed plans for 2025 through 2028 potential sections of roads that will need attention. Both overlay projects and improvement projects. Public Works is using a program which helps them assess and make recommendations for the next couple years of projects in both roads and paved trails. Martens discussed briefly next year's projects as well as the 5-year plan.

Parking Dept – Hardware and program is sunsetting soon. Had it since 2017.

Other projects briefly discussed included the Woodbridge Bridge, WE-Cycle program, Villas North, Snowmass Inn, the Community Garden, Carriage Way Housing, and Composting.

The GID meeting is on Nov 6th.

9) TOWN COUNCIL REPORTS AND ACTIONS

Councilmember Marolt had no updates.

Councilmember Shenk has NWCCOG this Thursday. She has concerns with the recent Snowmass Club removal of willows along Brush Creek. Kinney said that TOSV has contacted GM of Snowmass Club to understand their goal going forward and the Town contacted the US Army Core and has not heard back. Brief discussion on a beaver dam removal two years ago along the Snowmass Club and Highline Road. Kinney confirmed we do not as a town remove beaver dams.

Mayor Madsen attended a Nordic Council meeting last week where they discussed snow making and challenges at the High School and Gulf Course.

Donation Request by Aspen Camp of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing

BACKGROUND:

Aspen Camp of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing has requested a donation of a surplus all-terrain vehicle (ATV) from the Town of Snowmass Village to aid with its operations.

Aspen Camp of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing is a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing a safe and welcoming environment for individuals of all ages who are deaf or hard of hearing. Located in Snowmass, the camp offers a wide range of outdoor activities and life-enriching programs aimed at fostering personal growth, independence, and a sense of community.

As part of Aspen Camp's ongoing efforts to maintain its campgrounds and ensure that all programs are delivered in a safe and accessible environment, the camp is seeking donation of an ATV. The camp's 17-acre property presents unique challenges for property maintenance, including the upkeep of trails, managing landscaping, and ensuring safe access to various areas of the property, particularly for campers and staff with mobility challenges.

Aspen Camp shared that an ATV would significantly improve the camp's ability to address these challenges in the following ways:

- **Trail Maintenance:** Facilitating the upkeep of trails and paths, ensuring easy access for campers and staff.
- **Snow Removal:** Assisting with snow removal during the winter months to maintain year-round access.
- **Transporting Materials:** Enabling the transport of materials and supplies to more remote areas of the camp, where traditional vehicles cannot easily access.
- **Supporting Accessibility:** Ensuring that the camp remains accessible to all campers, including those with mobility impairments.

The Town currently has one surplus ATV that is set to go to auction later this year that could be donated to the Aspen Camp of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing. The estimated value of the donated ATV at auction is a maximum of \$2,000.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The value of the surplus ATV at auction is estimated at \$1,500 – 2,000.

BACKGROUND:

The proposed agreement on the Parking Plan (see attached) between the Town, the Aspen Skiing Company (ASC), Snowmass Mountain Lodging, LLC (SML), and Base Village Metropolitan District #1 (BVMD1) is provided for your review. Staff have communicated with the ASC, SML and a representative of BVMD1 on the parking plan for the coming winter season. The parking plan defines the goals and objectives for the parking system which include:

- Keeping parking usage at or below 85% (National standard for a full lot) of capacity so that guests can find the available parking; and
- Reducing vehicle miles travelled and thus carbon emissions; and
- Promoting alternative modes of travel.

For the coming ski season parking capacity at Town Park will be increased compared to the 2023/2024 due to the completion of the new rodeo arena. Enforcement and the responsibilities of the various parties will largely remain the same as last winter with the exception of Two Creeks, which will now be entirely managed by ASC in conjunction with their new parking kiosk system. The Town will continue to use its digital parking system with vehicles being registered and tracked by their license plate.

The parking garage in Base Village will remain free for the first hour of parking. For the 2024-2025 season garage parking will be \$9 per hour up to \$63 for the day until 4:00 pm with a peak season rate of \$12 per hour up to \$84 for the day. ASC pricing at Two Creeks for the 2024/2025 ski season will remain at \$25 for weekdays and \$35 for weekends and holidays.

To match the increase in day parking rates at Base Village citations have been raised to \$80 (from \$50-\$60) for most violations, including no permit and timed parking violations. Some more serious citations such as parking in the roadway and in a Fire Lane have been increased to \$100. Parking in disabled citations have been increased to \$200.

Due to last season's reductions in gold and senior permits and consistent effort by parking department staff to ensure compliance with parking rules and regulations in the numbered lots the number of available permits for Snowmass Village businesses and their employees can be slightly increased this season. Not only will this help to free up day-skier parking capacity at the Town Park Lot, it will also improve operations of businesses and lodges that operate out of the mall and numbered lots that have been historically restricted to a number of employee permits below their actual staffing levels.

Finally, some work was done to add or remove language in the parking plan that was either no longer true or needed to be changed to better reflect desired operations and management .

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The increase in parking citations will add slightly to enforcement revenues.

APPLICABILITY TO COUNCIL GOALS & OBJECTIVES:

All changes are consistent with the Town's objectives of managing the available public parking within the Town to help control traffic volume in the community, thus reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Additionally this plan helps promote the operations of locally owned and locally serving businesses.

COUNCIL OPTIONS:

1. Approve the Parking Plan as recommended
2. Amend and approve the Parking Plan and/or the pricing increases
3. Do not approve the Parking Plan and the pricing increases.

AGREEMENT ON PARKING PLAN FOR WINTER 2024/2025

This agreement is entered into on a date to be determined, by and between the Town of Snowmass Village (“Town”), Aspen Skiing Company (“ASC”), Snowmass Mountain Lodging, LLC (“SML”), and Base Village Metropolitan District No. 1 (“BVMD”).

RECITALS

The Town, ASC, SML, and BVMD (the “Parties”) agree to share and coordinate the management of parking operations and facilities within Snowmass Village (“Village”) for the winter season of 2024/2025. The Town owns the land for the parking areas known as “Numbered,” “Town Park,” “Rodeo Contestant” and “Divide Lot E” parking lots. ASC owns and/or is managing parking in the areas known as “Tree House,” “Two Creeks,” and “Black Saddle Clubhouse.” BVMD manages the parking within the parking garage in “Base Village.” The Parties agree to observe the parking and transit goals of the Town’s Comprehensive Plan - Ordinance NO. 09 Series of 2018 (the “Comprehensive Plan”), and the conditions of Ordinance NO. 09, Series of 1994 (“Ordinance 9”) approving the ski area expansion. This parking plan is an effort by the Parties to observe these guidelines and objectives for the betterment of the whole community. The Parties will communicate during the ski season to monitor the parking and traffic activities resulting from this plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

To comply with the three parking/transit goals and directives of the Comprehensive Plan and Ordinance 9: 1.) Manage the total number of day parking spaces within the community and the lots west of the Wooden Skier Bridge for the purpose of controlling traffic volume; 2.) Work to achieve a parking utilization rate of 85% of the day use parking spaces, and 3.) Monitor traffic impacts to maintain a Level of Service (LOS) standard of “D” or better to be consistent with the community’s goal in the current Comprehensive Plan. Agreement on the parking program elements that affect these goals and directives are as follows:

- A. **Traffic Volume/Level of Service:** The Parties agree to continue to monitor the traffic volume/level of service (LOS) on Brush Creek Rd, Owl Creek Rd and Highline Rd. In the past, variations have occurred in the traffic volume/LOS on Brush Creek Rd and Owl Creek Rd; however, they were not considered consistent or significant enough to change the relative traffic volume/LOS for those roadways as they are established in the Comprehensive Plan. If the traffic volume increases to a point where it exceeds any limit set in the Comprehensive Plan, the Parties will meet to discuss possible changes to parking fees and parking distribution to bring the traffic volumes back to acceptable limits.
- B. **Parking Capacity and Distribution:** The Parties have agreed to a limit of 2,425 public parking spaces to be managed by the Parties to ensure a balanced distribution of the parking within the Village that supports the traffic volume/LOS on our roadways. The Parties agree to the allocation of parking space numbers in general and accept that some flexibility to shift parking spaces between locations is beneficial under certain conditions. With the completion of the Base Village elements to date, the number of public parking spaces in this agreement will be 2,387 spaces. The distribution of parking spaces in the Village for Winter 2024/2025, will be:

- C. **Parking Groups:** Parking groups referred to in this document will be identified by their historical titles: Day Skier, Day Skier High Occupancy Vehicle (" Day Skier HOV"), Base Village Garage, Resident (including restricted resident access to Numbered lots 10-13), Guest, Employee (including restricted employee access to Numbered lots 10 - 13), Gold Pass, Senior, Merchant, Disabled, and Temporary/Construction access.
- D. **Parking Prices:** Parking prices will be consistent with the Town’s Municipal Code and associated with the following user groups:

Day Skier:	The variable price of Day Skier access will generally be between \$0 and \$35 (Two Creeks will be \$25 for a weekday and more for weekend & holidays, \$35);
Day Skier HOV:	HOV access will be free to vehicles with four or more occupants at Two Creeks and Divide Lot E - this does not apply to the Base Village parking garage.
Base Village Garage:	The fee for use of the Base Village parking garage will be free for the first hour (subject to the Metro Improvement District approval) and then a charge of 9for every hour after that up to 63for the day. A peak rate of \$12 for every hour up to \$84 during the following periods: December 25 th 2024-January 5 th 2025, MLK- January 17, 2025-January 20, 2025, Presidents Day-February 14,2025-February 17, 2025, All of March 2025. Manager can remove the above peak dates and reduce rates at their discretion. Base Village will charge for vehicles parking before 4:00 pm and for vehicles entering after 4:00 pm parking will be free. The price for Day Skier parking access will attempt to achieve a parking utilization rate of 85% in the Base Village and Two Creeks lots (as stated in Ordinance 9, Series of 1994) as long as the traffic volumes along roadways in the Village stay within the parameters set in the Comprehensive Plan;

Base Village Garage Valet:	The fee for Base Village Public Valet Parking will be at an hourly rate not to exceed the maximum of the day parking fee.
Resident 1 st Vehicle:	Residents' first vehicle will be \$80;
Resident 2 nd Vehicle:	Residents' second vehicle will be \$120;
Resident 3 rd Vehicle:	Residents' third vehicle will be \$220;
Restricted Resident:	Residents' having restricted access will be \$60;
Guest Access:	Access for guest vehicles will be \$15/day;
Gold Access:	Resident or guest within the Roaring Fork Valley will be \$650;
Senior Access:	Resident or guest within the Roaring Fork Valley 70 years of age or older will be \$325. Gold and Senior permits combined are restricted to 100 permits (15 Gold & 85 Senior), which will be drawn through a lottery system.;
Employee Single Vehicle:	Employee single vehicle will be \$70;
Employee Transferable:	For employees to have access for one of multiple vehicles will be \$110;
Restricted Employee:	Employee access to restricted areas will be \$60;
ASC Employee:	Access to the Black Saddle lot will be in the \$0 to \$50 range;
Merchant Parking:	Merchant parking will be \$750/space with a maximum five vehicles/space;
Temporary/Construction/ Social/Non-Profit:	Access will be issued at the discretion of the Parking Department in conjunction with the Police Department.

1. The enforcement of parking access in the Numbered lots will be from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. Time Restricted parking in the Numbered lots will be enforced from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm. The enforcement of parking in the ASC lots will be from 8:00 am to: 12:00 pm. The enforcement of parking in Base Village will be from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. The Town may patrol the Garage and assist with enforcement of certain aspects of this parking agreement, subject to the parties agreeing to do so.
2. ASC is limited to 175 applications for the Town's Employee parking access. ASC employees without a parking permit for the numbered lots will be encouraged to park at the Black Saddle or to use public transportation. Employees parking at the Town Park Lot will be discouraged.
3. The Town will be responsible for the management, signing, leasing, and maintenance of the parking lots in the West Village known as the Numbered lots and the Divide Lot E.
4. ASC will be responsible for the management, signing, leasing, and maintenance of the Black Saddle, Town Park, Rodeo Contestant, and Two Creeks lots. ASC will also be responsible for the management of the parking in the Tree House lots during peak ski school activity. ASC will manage access and enforcement at the Two Creeks lots.
5. ASC will be responsible for providing parking attendants at the Town Park Lot on Weekends and any other day when parking demand reaches a level requiring the presence of attendants to ensure efficient use of the Lot.
6. BVMD will be responsible for the Base Village parking garage, and the Tree House lots outside of peak ski school activity.
7. Any services provided by one organization to the other for the management, signing or maintenance of the parking areas, such as sanding or plowing, will be compensated on a case-by-case basis.
8. Each party will retain the revenues derived from their respective parking sales parking enforcement ticket payments.

9. The Parties agree to allow police enforcement in all lots under this general management parking plan, compliant with the Snowmass Village Municipal Code, Chapter 8, Article II, Parking Regulations.

10. The Town will be responsible for management of vehicles having access to Town parking lots and delivery vehicles; and ASC, SML and BVMD will be responsible for management of day visitors.

11. ASC will advertise on their app, website, and/or social media to encourage day skiers to utilize public transportation and inform skiers of limited public parking in the Village during peak periods (as stated in Ordinance 9).

12. Should it appear that the ski area parking lots will be full, ASC will update their app to reflect which lots are at their capacity. The Variable Messaging Sign (VMS) on eastbound Highway 82 west of Brush Creek will be updated to reflect that lots have reached their capacity. ASC will also make this information available to the public via Pitkin County Emergency Alert, in conjunction with Town Police Department (as stated in Ordinance 9).

13. Term. The term of this agreement shall be from November 28th through and until April 30th, 2025 or the closing of the Winter 2024/2025ski season at the Snowmass Ski Area, whichever occurs first.

14. Default and Dispute Resolution. In the event of any default in performance of any obligations hereunder, within 15 days of any default, the non-defaulting party shall give the other written notice of the default. After delivery of notice, the defaulting party shall then have fifteen days in which to cure the default. If the default is not cured within such period, then the non-defaulting party may terminate this agreement after such period. The Parties agree to use reasonable best efforts to informally discuss and attempt to resolve any apparent event of default prior to delivery of notice thereof.

Divide Lot E:	Day Skier, Day Skier HOV, Employee, Employee Trans., Gold Pass, Guest, Resident 1-3, and Senior - No overnight parking without prior approval by owner;
Two Creeks Lots:	Day Skier, Day Skier HOV, Guest, "Equal Access" will be applied to all day parking here - No overnight parking without prior approval by owner;
Black Saddle Clubhouse:	ASC Employee and Day Skier - No overnight parking without prior approval by owner;
Town Park:	Free to all for day parking for recreation and/or shopping purposes - No overnight parking without prior approval by owner; and
Rodeo Contestant Lot:	Free to all for day parking for recreation and/or shopping purposes – no overnight parking without prior approval by owner.

1. The enforcement of parking access in the Numbered lots will be from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. Time Restricted parking in the Numbered lots will be enforced from ~~7:00~~ 8:00 am to 7:00 pm. The enforcement of parking in the ASC lots will be from 8:00 am to: 12:00 pm. The enforcement of parking in Base Village will be from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. The Town may patrol the Garage and assist with enforcement of certain aspects of this parking agreement, subject to the parties agreeing to do so.

2. ASC is limited to ~~150-175~~ applications for the Town's Employee parking access. ASC employees without a parking permit for the numbered lots will be encouraged to park at the Black Saddle or to use public transportation. Employees parking at the Town Park Lot will be discouraged.

3. The Town will be responsible for the management, signing, leasing, and maintenance of the parking lots in the West Village known as the Numbered lots and the Divide Lot E.

4. ASC will be responsible for the management, signing, leasing, and maintenance of the Black Saddle, Town Park, Rodeo Contestant, and Two Creeks lots. ASC will also be responsible for the management of the parking in the Tree House lots during peak ski school activity. ASC will manage access and enforcement at the Two Creeks lots.

5. ASC will be responsible for providing parking attendants at the Town Park Lot on Weekends and any other day when parking demand reaches a level requiring the presence of attendants to ensure efficient use of the Lot.

65. BVMD will be responsible for the Base Village parking garage, and the Tree House lots outside of peak ski school activity.

76. Any services provided by one organization to the other for the management, signing or maintenance of the parking areas, such as sanding or plowing, will be compensated on a case-by-case basis.

87. Each party will retain the revenues derived from their respective parking sales parking enforcement ticket payments.

98. The Parties agree to allow police enforcement in all lots under this general management parking plan, compliant with the Snowmass Village Municipal Code, Chapter 8, Article II, Parking Regulations.

109. ~~The Parties agree to share the operational function of any information booth(s) relative to parking management at the entrance to the community when necessary.~~ The Town will be responsible for management of vehicles having access to Town parking lots and delivery vehicles; and ASC, SML and BVMD will be responsible for management of day visitors.

110. ASC will advertise on ~~the local radio~~their app, website, and/or social media to encourage day skiers to utilize public transportation and inform skiers of limited public parking in the Village during peak periods (as stated in Ordinance 9).

121. Should it appear that the ski area parking lots will be full, ASC will update their app to reflect which lots are at their capacity~~post information signs on Brush Creek Rd before Highline Rd and at the intersection of Brush Creek Rd with Highway 82 (subject to Colorado Department of Transportation and Pitkin County approval) indicating which lots are at their capacity. The Variable Messaging Sign (VMS) on eastbound Highway 82 west of Brush Creek will be updated to reflect that lots have reached their capacity.~~ ASC will also make this information available to the public via Pitkin County Emergency Alert, in conjunction with Town Police Department,~~the radio and public television~~ (as stated in Ordinance 9).

132. Term. The term of this agreement shall be from November ~~24th~~28th through and until April ~~30th~~, ~~2025~~2024 or the closing of the Winter ~~2023/2024~~2024/2025 ski season at the Snowmass Ski Area, whichever occurs first.

143. Default and Dispute Resolution. In the event of any default in performance of any obligations hereunder, within 15 days of any default, the non-defaulting party shall give the other written notice of the default. After delivery of notice, the defaulting party shall then have fifteen days in which to cure the default. If the default is not cured within such period, then the non-defaulting party may terminate this agreement after such period. The Parties agree to use reasonable best efforts to informally discuss and attempt to resolve any apparent event of default prior to delivery of notice thereof.

BACKGROUND:

Section 8.3 of the Home Rule Charter states that members of all boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Town Council. The vacancies have been publicly posted, advertised in the Snowmass Sun and posted on social media from September 13th to November 8th.

We have received 36 applications, 11 new and 25 incumbents. Attached is a breakdown of each Board including the number of vacant seats and number of total applications.

We are going to utilize a new tool in this process. It is called **Spark Hire**. Candidates will video record responses to the 3 questions and then Council will receive an email with a link and instructions to view the short interviews. Council will then discuss at upcoming meetings on December 2nd and 9th. Appointments will take place on the December 16th and/or the January 6th meeting. This is a quick turnaround made even shorter with the election season. I believe Spark Hire will be a useful tool this year and your feedback will be most welcome as we continue to make improvements to the process.
