Minutes

1. Roll Call

Meeting called to order at 4:01 PM.

2. Approval of Minutes

2.A. 11-04-25 EAB Draft Minutes

3. C.O.R.E. Update

Gina McCrackin introduced Cedric Gamble as the new Director of Climate Action Programs at CORE. Attendance by a CORE representative at future EAB meetings might need to be fulfilled by Gina as the primary board member and Cedric as an alternate board member to guarantee CORE's presence.

CORE updated the board on 2025 awards and will present an update on the 2026 funding and costs of the program at the next EAB meeting.

4. H.C.E. Update

Mike Steiner updated the board on Holy Cross' successful heat pump program and collaborations with CORE for other programs.

5. Items for Discussion

5.A. 2026 Sustainability Budget Allocation

Discussion of the 2026 EAB Sustainability Budget Allocation of \$300,000 to be presented to the Monday, January 12 Town Council Work Session.

The Roaring Fork Valley Wildfire Collaborative will cover the costs to complete the survey, modeling project and subsequent targeted programs so there is no need to allocate anything additional to wildfire. CORE's rollover of 2025 funds allocated to the Building Electrification rebate program will likely cover costs of projects in Snowmass for 2026.

EAB's 2026 Budget priority is hiring or contracting to fill a Sustainability Coordinator position, the Water proposal to be presented by Snowmass Water District at the rescheduled January 7 EAB meeting, and beginning work in Q1 & Q2 on the Demo & Construction Pilot and the Commercial Composting Program.
