Parks, Recreation and Trails Director Andy Worline, Assistant Parks, Recreation & Trails Director Riley Bonilla, Trails Supervisor Ryan Lipari, and POST Manager Jake Moe appeared and summarized the item for discussion. The Mid-Rim Trail proposal is working with the homeowners, Aspen Valley Land Trust (AVLT) and IMBA Trail Solutions in these early stages of development.
