4. Administrative Updates & Discussion Items

Greg LeBlanc gave brief Town updates:

- Connecting the nodes project - Council & Staff are looking at better ways to connect the commercial centers and improve wayfinding.
- Roundabout at Brush and Owl Creek - Looking at possible phasing and potential funding. Construct to start in 2025 if the Council gives direction. Members discussed the possibility of PTRAB having a position on this project. With differing opinions - both opposition and in favor, Chair Mayer will follow up with members to discuss further. It was pointed out that at least 50% of monies will be spent regardless since certain aspects of the project still need to be addressed - underground utilities, water and sanitation, and safety improvements. Chair Mayer will do a quick 2/3 question survey out to PTRAB and then discuss in a month or two.
- Rodeo - Members expressed concerns about the landscaping at the Rodeo and the need for some improvements to mask/hide the stands as you approach the town. Questions about the LED Signage and how it flashes. The sign and lack of landscaping gives a negative impression of area and Rodeo facility. Rodeo seems happy with improvements - a few small issues including audio, are being addressed.

4.a Town Updates

Concerns about the landscaping at Rodeo needs improvements to mask the stands as you approach the town. Jeff - LED Signage - Flashing - negative impression of area due to sign and Rodeo facility. Rodeo seems happy with improvements - a few small issues - audio - being addressed.
