- ❖ **CALL TO ORDER:** Meeting brought to order at 3:00 p.m.

- ❖ **Plein Air Festival:**

 - The preview and prize giving should happen before the event next year. There was a suggestion of inviting the sponsors to this event as well.
 - Invite Julie to next months meeting to see if they would like to continue this event.
- ❖ Update on Ice Cubes
- Kyle heard from Joe and the only ice cube that they've tried to create has failed. The earliest that the cubes will be completed is November-December.
 - Look into options if this piece of art falls through.
 - Will the final product be durable?
- ❖ Indoor Exhibits
- Lois hasn't gotten too into this as we have all been busy with the Plein Air Festival. Villas at Snowmass would have a space for art. We will require more information to make a good decision.
- ❖ Art Loans
- This is being worked on by Meriwether. We will touch base the next time she attends a meeting.
- ❖ New Business
- Carol brought up an idea of a Japanese gate at the entrance of the Rim Trail. She will send a photo of sample art out to the group.
 - There was a discussion amongst the group about future art locations.
